Terra Green Industries, LLC is the builder, owner and operator of the Commercial Torrefaction Demonstration Facility that is being built in McKean County, Pennsylvania.

Mr. Halloran, who is the owner of the American Refining Group along with several other companies, has focused on energy most of his professional life with the ownership of not only the ARG petroleum refinery in Bradford, but a wind company and now a biomass company.

Mr. Golubock, who currently serves as President and Chief Operating Officer of the American Refining Group, has held positions of increasing executive authority in Witco prior to his current role at ARG. As a Witco executive and as President & COO of ARG Mr. Golubock has experience in technology, technology licensing, process guarantees, engineering, and administration.

Mr. Causer, who serves as President and Chief Operating Officer of Terra Green Energy, LLC began his career at Quaker State Oil Refining Corporation in the late 1970's. Upon the sales of the Farmers Valley and Emlenton refineries to Petrowax PA Inc. he was promoted Plant Manager of the Farmers Valley refinery and then to VP Manufacturing with responsibilities at both refineries. With the sale of Petrowax to Astor Corporation he became VP, General Manager of Astor's refining division. Astor Corporation eventually became part of AlliedSignal/Honeywell Corporation. His responsibilities included all refinery operations, process and project engineering, product design and formulation,

HS&E (health, safety, and environmental compliance), human resources, feedstock acquisition, and semi-refined product sales.

Ms. Michele D. Alfieri-Causar, Esq. is an attorney licensed to practice in Ohio and Pennsylvania. As an attorney for over twenty years she has held numerous elected and administrative positions including eight (8) years as District Attorney, County Solicitor, and County Administrator where she was responsible for an administrative system of over 200 employees and a budget of over \$28 million.
